Reflection

When the rich man in hell requested that someone from the dead should go and speak to his five brothers, Abraham replied that "if they do not listen to Moses and the Prophets, they will not be convinced even if someone rises from the dead". When Jesus appears here to his disciples, he does not simply show himself to be a living person; he opens their minds to an understanding of the Scriptures. Today we do not have the privilege of seeing the body of our risen Lord face-to-face, but we have the Old and New Testament Scriptures, which bear witness to him.
