## Reflection

Our reading from the Gospel of Mark shares two stories about Jesus ministering to two Gentiles. As Jesus ministered to them in unique and marvellous ways, we see how it is true that He does all things well. We can trust that Jesus will continue to do all things well in our lives.

We will concentrate on the first story, highlighting a woman's faith.

The reading notes an exchange between a gentile mother and Jesus. This Gentile mother had displayed wisdom, humility, and faith, and therefore, Jesus was so pleased by her response that He granted her request. This woman understood the Gospel – which declares that you're more wicked than you ever believed, but at the same time more loved and accepted than you ever dared to hope.
