## John's Reflection

### Luke 10: 1-11 – The sending out of the seventy-two.

The mission field is tough, but the fact that it is also of absolute importance motivates those who are sent. The joy flows not from their success, but from their identification with Jesus and with Jesus' people.

In the church today when we talk of the church's mission we tend to duck for cover. It's the responsibility of others; not me. We see the church aging and numbers declining and are at lost to see how this can change. Henry Nouwen challenges us to see the miracle of multiplication:

The opposite of a scarcity mentality is an abundancy mentality. With an abundancy mentality we say: "There is enough for everyone, more than enough food, knowledge, love ..... everything." With this mindset we give away whatever we have, to whomever we meet. When we see hungry people we give them food. When we meet ignorant people we share our knowledge; when we encounter people in the need of love, we offer them friendship and affection and hospitality and introduce them to our family and friends.

When we live with this mind set, we will see the miracle that what we give away multiplies: food, knowledge, love ..... everything. There will even be many leftovers.

Keep journeying in faith.
