Naaman Healed of Leprosy

Now Naaman was commander of the army of the king of Aram. He was a great man in the sight of his master and highly regarded, because through him the Lord had given victory to Aram. He was a valiant soldier, but he had leprosy. Now bands from Aram had gone out and had taken captive a young girl from Israel, and she served Naaman's wife. She said to her mistress, "if only my master would see the prophet who is in Samaria! He would cure him of his leprosy. Naaman went to his master and told him what the girl had said. "By all means, go" the King of Aram replied full stop. "I will send a letter to the king of Israel." So Naaman left, taking with him ten talents of silver, six thousand shekels of gold and ten sets of clothing

So Elisha sent a messenger to say to him, "go, wash yourself seven times in the Jordan, and your flesh will be restored and you will be cleansed." Naaman said: "Couldn't I wash in the rivers of Damascus, better than rivers of Israel. Couldn't I wash in them and be cleansed?" Naaman servants said if the Prophet told you to do some great thing, would you not have done it? How much more then, when he tells you wash and be cleansed!" So he went down and dipped himself in the Jordan seven times, as the man of God had told him, and his flesh was restored and he became clean as that of a young boy.
